BY-LAW No. 1090-2001

To layout and dedicate certain land on the south side of Lake Shore Boulevard West, west of Palace Pier Court for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard West.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public highway Lake Shore Boulevard West, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 07624-0064 (LT).

Parcel 25-16, Section B-1176.

Being part of Lot 25 on Plan 1176, designated as PARTS 1 to 8, inclusive, on Plan 66R-18899.

Metropolitan Toronto Land Titles Division (No. 66).

City of Toronto (formerly the City of Etobicoke), Province of Ontario.

is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Lake Shore Boulevard West.
