SCHEDULE "A"


- 1. Section 18 of the Official Plan for the former City of Toronto is amended by adding a new Section 18.545 and Map 18.545 as follows:
 - 18.545 Lands knows as 70 High Park Avenue

See Map 18.545 at the end of this Section.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Plan, Council may pass by-laws applicable to the lands indicated on the map attached hereto, to permit the erection and use of a building for *residential* uses provided that:

- (1) the *residential gross floor area* of such building does not exceed 11,870 square metres; and
- (2) the owner is required to enter into an agreement pursuant to Section 37 of the *Planning Act* to secure the restoration, conservation and maintenance of portions of the church building located on the lands and to make a cash contribution to the City for the purposes of improvements to local area parks and local school board playgrounds.
