BY-LAW No. 1108-2001

To Appoint an Acting City Solicitor.

WHEREAS Harry William Osmond Doyle was appointed City Solicitor for the City of Toronto by By-law No. 29-1998 as amended; and

WHEREAS Mr. Doyle will retire as City Solicitor on February 5, 2002; and

WHEREAS the Rules of Civil Procedure for the Ontario Courts require a solicitor of record to act for the City; and

WHEREAS the Rules of Civil Procedure require the City to appoint a new solicitor of record; and

WHEREAS the recruitment of a new City Solicitor will not be finalized prior to the retirement of the City Solicitor; and

WHEREAS Article V of Chapter 169, City Officials, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code sets out the powers and duties of the Solicitor;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 29-1998 as amended is hereby repealed.
2. Margaret A. Fischer is appointed Acting City Solicitor for the City of Toronto and shall have all the powers and duties imposed upon the Solicitor by Article V, of Chapter 169, City Officials, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.
3. This By-law shall come into force on February 6, 2002.
