# CITY OF TORONTO

# **BY-LAW No. 17-2002**

# To amend City of North York By-law No. 7625 in respect of lands municipally known as 825 Don Mills Road.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this by-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Schedules "B" and "C" of By-law No. 7625 of the former City of North York are amended in accordance with Schedule "1" of this by-law.
- **2.** Section 64.34(17) of By-law No. 7625 of the former City of North York is amended by deleting the text of the section and replacing it with the following:

**"64.34(17) MO(17)** 

### PERMITTED USES

(a) In addition to the uses permitted in the MO zone, a dry cleaning and laundry collecting establishment and a car washing establishment are also permitted uses ancillary to a retail store.

### **EXCEPTION REGULATIONS**

- (b) Section 34(2)(b)(iii) shall not apply.
- (c) The total maximum gross floor area for a retail store, service shop, dry cleaning and laundry collecting establishment and a car washing establishment shall be  $14,610 \text{ m}^2$ .
- (d) For a retail store, service shop, dry cleaning and laundry collecting establishment and a car washing establishment, a minimum of 1 parking space per 25 m<sup>2</sup> of gross floor area (excluding enclosed loading, garbage and recycling areas) shall be provided.
- (e) Notwithstanding Section 34(6)(b)(i), the first 9 metres of the minimum front yard setback shall be landscaped, except for driveways entering and exiting from the lot directly onto the street.
- (f) Section 6(A)(10) shall not apply.


- (g) The minimum yard setbacks shall be as shown on Schedule "MO(17)".
- (h) Outside storage, outside sales and outside display of items for sale are permitted in conjunction with a retail store, to a total maximum area of 500 m<sup>2</sup>".
- **3.** Section 64.34(17) of By-law No. 7625 is amended by adding the attached Schedule "MO(17)".


