# To amend Scarborough Zoning By-law No. 10827, as amended, with respect to the Highland Creek Community.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. SCHEDULE "A" is amended by deleting the current zoning so that the amended zoning shall read as follows on Schedule '1':

$$S - 56 - 97 - 126 - 138 - 147 - 365$$

2. SCHEDULE "B", PERFORMANCE STANDARD CHART, is amended by adding the following Performance Standards:

## BUILDING SETBACK FROM LOT LINES OTHER THAN STREET LINES

126. Minimum rear yard 5 metres.

### **BUILDING SETBACK FROM STREETS**

147. Minimum **flankage yard** 1.9 metres.

## **INTENSITY OF USE**

- 365. One **Single-Family dwelling** per parcel of land with a minimum of 14 metres frontage on a public **street** and a minimum lot area of 390 square metres.
- **3. SCHEDULE "C",** is amended by deleting Exception No. 14 and Exception No. 19.


