CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 82-2002

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

Plains Road	South	A point 34.6 metres east of Northridge Avenue and Durant Avenue	8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday except public holidays

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule.

2. Schedule X (Parking for Restricted Periods) of By-law No. 92-93, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Plains Road	South	A point 53 metres east of Northridge Avenue and a point 56 metres further east thereof	7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday	10 minutes

3. This By-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
