CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 87-2002

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule X (Parking for Restricted Periods) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Kingston Road (M.T. 4)	North	Victoria Park Avenue and Birchmount Road	Anytime	1 hour

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Kingston Road (M.T. 4)	North	Victoria Park Avenue and Fallingbrook Road	Anytime	1 hour
Kingston Road (M.T. 4)	North	A point 77 metres east of Fallingbrook Road and Birchmount Road	Anytime	1 hour

2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Warden Avenue, east side, and driveway located approximately 85 metres south of Metropolitan Road (M.T. 65)	Westbound	Left	Anytime

3. Schedule XVI (Compulsory Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Sheppard Avenue East (M.T. 28)	Exit/Driveway from No. 5060 Sheppard Avenue East, located on the north side of Sheppard Avenue East, opposite Scunthorpe Road	Scunthorpe Road
