BY-LAW No. 133-2002

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane north of Queen Street West extending easterly from Lisgar Street.

WHEREAS certain land was acquired by the City in connection with the Commissioner of Urban Development Services' Statement of Approval dated March 8, 2001 respecting 1118-1122 Queen Street West.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane north of Queen Street West extending easterly from Lisgar Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of Lot 66 on Plan D-186 and parts of Lots B and C on Plan 531 designated as PARTS 1 and 2 on Plan 64R-17010 both said Plans being in the Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes to form part of public lane north of Queen Street West extending easterly from Lisgar Street.
