BY-LAW No. 139-2002

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane east of Dufferin Street extending southerly from Hallam Street.

WHEREAS certain land was acquired by the City in connection with a Committee of Adjustment Decision dated July 9, 1999 respecting 1181A and 1183 Dufferin Street;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane east of Dufferin Street extending southerly from Hallam Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of parts of Lots 18, 19 and 20 in Block O on Plan 622-York designated as PART 3 on Plan 64R-16353, both said Plans being in the Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes to form part of public lane east of Dufferin Street extending southerly from Hallam Street.
