CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 214-2002

To amend further City of Toronto By-law No. 574-2000, a By-law “Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, businesses and occupations in the City of Toronto”, respecting replacement of taxicabs.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 53 of Schedule 8 to By-law No. 574-2000, a By-law “Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, businesses and occupations in the City of Toronto”, is amended by adding the following sub-sections:
 - (1.1) In this section, “third mechanical examination” means the third regularly scheduled mechanical examination pursuant to section 49 of this Schedule.
 - (1.2) Notwithstanding any other provision in this Schedule, a Standard taxicab shall not be replaced with a motor vehicle that has been used as a police vehicle in any jurisdiction or as a taxicab in any jurisdiction except the City of Toronto.
2. Sub-section 53(5)(a) of Schedule 8 to By-law No. 574-2000 is amended by deleting the word “second” and inserting the word “third” in lieu thereof.
3. Sub-section 53(6)(a) of Schedule 8 to By-law No. 574-2000 is amended by deleting the word “second” and inserting the word “third” in lieu thereof.
4. Section 53.3 of Schedule 8 to By-law No. 574-2000 is amended by adding the words “in the City of Toronto” after the words “registered taxicab” and before the words “in the 45 day period”.
5. Section 53.4 of Schedule 8 to By-law No. 574-2000 is amended by adding the words “in the City of Toronto” after the words “registered taxicab” and before the words “in the 45 day period”.
6. Section 53.5 of Schedule 8 to By-law No. 574-2000 is amended by adding the words “in the City of Toronto” after the words “registered taxicab” and before the words “in the 45 day period”.
