BY-LAW No. 244-2002

To stop up and close the road allowance known as Sovereign Avenue and to authorize the sale thereof.

WHEREAS it is recommended that the road allowance known as Sovereign Avenue be stopped up and closed as a public highway and be sold on the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 9 of North York Community Council Report No. 9, as adopted by Council at its meeting held on December 4, 5 and 6, 2001; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to stop up and close the said highway and to authorize the sale thereof was published in the Toronto Sun on February 1, 8, 15 and 22, 2002 and no one who claimed that the person's land would be prejudicially affected by the said by-law applied to be heard;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The road allowance known as Sovereign Avenue, described as follows:

PIN 10267-0203 (R)

Part of the Public Highway Sovereign Avenue on Plan 3633, designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 64R-8000 in the Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of North York) and Province of Ontario is hereby stopped up and closed as a public highway.

2. The soil and freehold of the public highway stopped up and closed by Section 1 of this By-law shall be sold on the terms and conditions set out in Clause No. 9 of North York Community Council Report No. 9, as adopted by Council at its meeting held on December 4, 5 and 6, 2001.
