BY-LAW No. 250-2002

**To designate certain lands known as the Niagara Area and the Massey Ferguson
Neighbourhood as a Community Improvement Project Area.**

WHEREAS subsection 28(2) of the *Planning Act* provides that the council of a municipality which has an Official Plan containing provisions relating to community improvement, may by by-law designate the whole or any part of an area covered by such an Official Plan as a Community Improvement Project Area; and

WHEREAS the Official Plan of the former City of Toronto contains provisions relating to community improvement which covers lands outlined by heavy lines on Map 1 attached to and forming part of this By-law; and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Toronto has authorized the designation of certain lands hereinafter described as a Community Improvement Project Area which is to be known as the Garrison Common North Community Improvement Project Area;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The area outlined by heavy lines shown on Map 1 attached to and forming part of this By-law is designated as a Community Improvement Project Area within the meaning of Section 28 of the *Planning Act*.

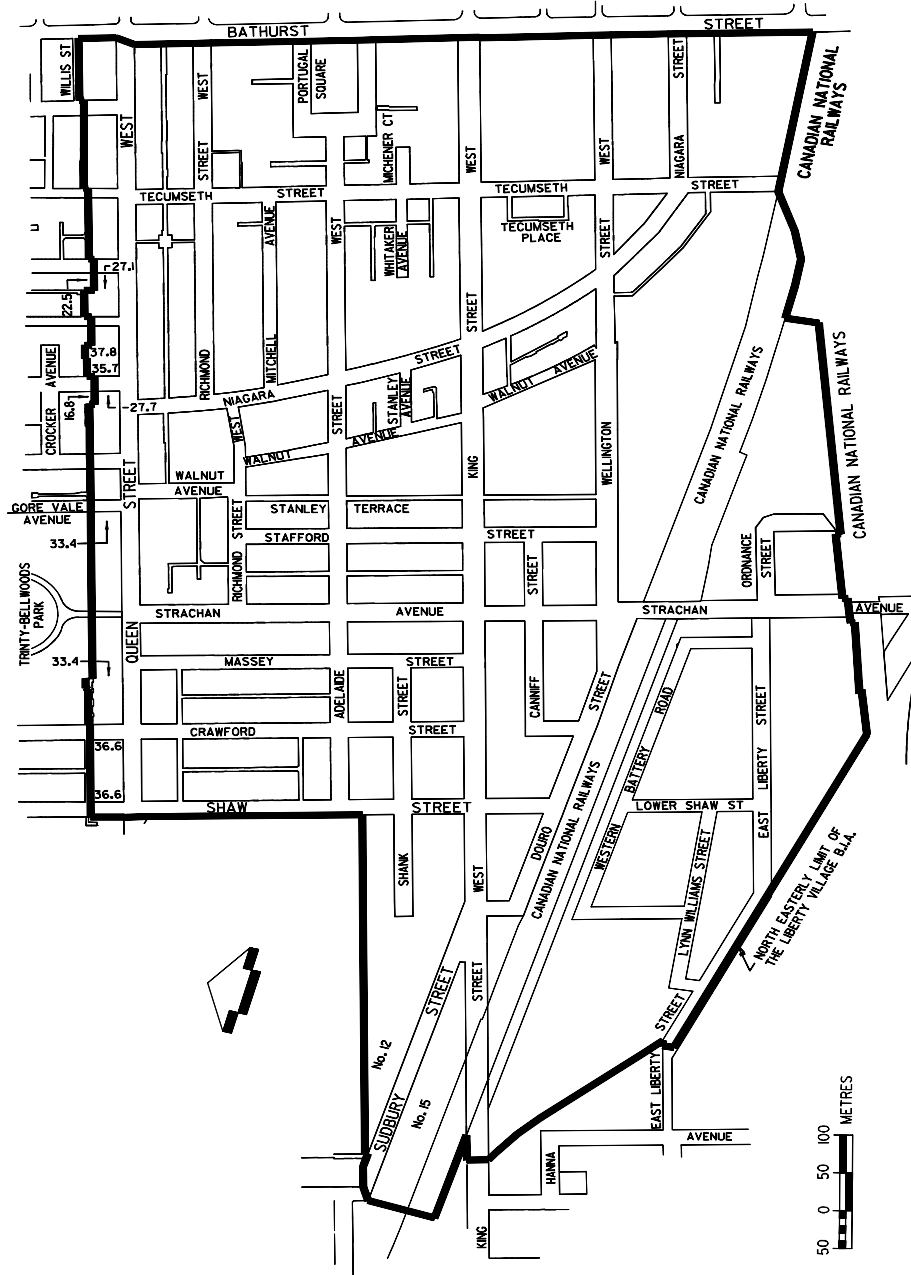
