CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 274-2002

To amend City of North York By-law No. 7625 in respect of lands municipally known as 22 Norfinch Drive.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 64.33(66) of By-law No.7625 is deleted and replaced with the following:

"64.33(66) MC(66)(H)

PERMITTED USES

(a) Notwithstanding Section 33(2), a nursing home is the only use permitted.

EXCEPTION REGULATIONS

- (b) Notwithstanding Section 33(5)(a), the maximum gross floor area shall be 9500 m² with a maximum floor space index of 1.2.
- (c) A minimum of 40 parking spaces shall be provided.
- (d) One loading space shall be provided.
- (e) The minimum yard setbacks shall be as shown on Schedule MC(66)(H).
- (f) A minimum of 24% of the front yard shall be landscaped.
- (g) Notwithstanding Section 6A(10)(e)(ii), parking spaces are permitted to within 1.3 m of the front lot line and the side lot line provisions shall not apply to the parking spaces located in the front yard.
- (h) A hedge or masonry wall is required between the edge of the parking spaces and the front lot line only where the parking spaces are located within 3.8 m of the front lot line".

2. Section 64.33 of By-law No. 7625 is amended by adding Schedule "MC(66)(H)" attached to this by-law.
