## **BY-LAW No. 277-2002**

# To amend City of North York By-law No. 7625 in respect of lands municipally known as 2710 Victoria Park Drive.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Schedules "B" and "C" of By-law No. 7625 of the former City of North York are amended in accordance with Schedule "1" of this by-law.
- 2. Section 64.13(61) of By-law No. 7625 is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

"64.13(61) R4(61)

### **PERMITTED USES**

(a) In addition to the uses permitted by the R4 zone, a personal service shop (hair salon) shall be permitted within a single family dwelling.

### **EXCEPTION REGULATIONS**


- (b) The maximum gross floor area for the personal service shop shall be  $69m^2$ .
- (c) The minimum rear yard setback to the east 8.0m portion of the single family dwelling shall be 6.3m.
- (d) The total number of personal use vehicles and other vehicles that may be parked outdoors in the rear yard shall not exceed 5".
