BY-LAW No. 285-2002

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of a new public lane outlet south of Eglinton Avenue West extending easterly from Northcliffe Boulevard.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of a new public lane outlet south of Eglinton Avenue West, extending easterly from Northcliffe Boulevard, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 10450-0105 (LT).

Part of Lot 36 on Plan 1996, designated as PART 1 on Plan 64R-16885 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of York) and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane outlet south of Eglinton Avenue West extending easterly from Northcliffe Boulevard.
