BY-LAW No. 298-2002

To amend the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 118, respecting 444 Yonge Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** By-law No. 118, being a By-law "Respecting Signs over Metropolitan Roads", as amended, is further amended by adding the following section:
 - 2I. Notwithstanding Section 2A of this By-law, signs extending over the west limit of Yonge Street adjacent to the building municipally known in the year 2001 as 444 Yonge Street may be permitted provided:
 - (a) in respect of 3 fascia curved signbands, overhead clearance of the signs is at least 2.75 metres above the level of the sidewalk and such signs do not extend more than 1.0 metre over the street line; and
 - (b) in respect of 4 banner signs, overhead clearance of the sign is 5.8 metres and extends for a further height of 3.75 metres and such signs do not extend more than 1.2 metres over the street line; and
 - (c) in respect of 4 banner signs, overhead clearance of the signs is 9.25 metres and extends for a further height of 8.5 metres and such signs do not extend more than 1.5 metres over the street line; and
 - (d) there is compliance with the requirements respecting the erection or alteration of signs specified in Sections 2 and 3.
- 2. By-law No. 36-2002 is repealed.
