BY-LAW No. 310-2002

**To rename Garden Avenue (Ward 41, Scarborough-Rouge River) as
“Garden Park Avenue”.**

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the highway renaming was published in a daily newspaper on March 12, 18, 25 and April 1, 2002 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on April 2, 2002;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Garden Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 06168-0320 (LT)

Garden Avenue on Plan 3932, Garden Avenue on Plan 4073, One Foot Reserve on Plan 3932 and part of Lot 22 Plan 3675 designated as PART 2 on Plan 64R-2787, being Garden Avenue between Pitfield Road and Fulham Street in the Metropolitan Toronto Land Titles Division (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario is renamed Garden Park Avenue.
