CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 314-2002

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane south of Danforth Avenue extending easterly from Luttrell Avenue, then northerly.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with the Commissioner of Urban Planning and Development Services' Statement of Approval/Undertaking U398004 respecting 640 Victoria Park Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane south of Danforth Avenue extending easterly from Luttrell Avenue, then northerly, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66), being composed of:

FIRSTLY:

Part of PIN 21013-0232 (LT)

Parts of Lots 1 and 2 in Concession 1 fronting the Bay, in the geographic Township of York, designated as PART 1 on Plan 64R-15967, saving and excepting thereout and therefrom PART 1 on Plan 64R-16054.

SECONDLY:

Part of PIN 21013-0244 (LT)

One Foot Reserve on Plan 766, designated as PART 2 on Plan 64R-15967 is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes to form part of public lane south of Danforth Avenue extending easterly from Luttrell Avenue, then northerly.
