BY-LAW No. 317-2002

To layout and dedicate certain land at the intersection of Queen's Drive and Upwood Avenue for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Upwood Avenue.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with the Committee of Adjustment Land Division Application B028/00NY 1999 respecting 359 Queen's Drive and 1A Upwood Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land at the intersection of Queen's Drive and Upwood Avenue to form part of the public highway Upwood Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 10330-0258 (LT)

Part of Lot 31 on Plan 1557 designated as PART 1 on Plan 64R-16678.

The easterly limit of Upwood Avenue as confirmed under the Boundaries Act by Plan BA-1367 (Plan 10850) in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of North York) and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Upwood Avenue.
