CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 321-2002

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane Broadcast Lane and part of the public lane north of Carlton Street extending westerly from Metcalfe Street, then northerly.

WHEREAS certain land was acquired by the City in connection with the Commissioner of Urban Planning and Development Services' Statement of Approval/Undertaking U398094;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public lane Broadcast Lane and part of the public lane north of Carlton Street extending westerly from Metcalfe Street, then northerly, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, in the Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) being composed of:

FIRSTLY: Land to form part of Broadcast Lane

Parts of Lots 4 and 5 on the west side of Metcalfe Street on Plan 26, designated as PARTS 9 and 10 on Plan 64R-16454.

SECONDLY: Land to form part of the public lane north of Carlton Street extending westerly from Metcalfe Street, then northerly

Part of the Private Lane on Plan 403, designated as PART 8 on Plan 64R-16454 is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes to form part of public lane Broadcast Lane and part of the public lane north of Carlton Street
