BY-LAW No. 322-2002

To layout and dedicate certain land at the intersection of Glencairn Avenue and Shermount Avenue for public highway purposes to form part of the public highway Glencairn Avenue.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with the Commissioner of Urban Planning and Development Services' Site Plan Approval dated June 12, 1998 respecting 712 Glencairn Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the public highway Glencairn Avenue, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 10220-0276 (R).

Being part of Lot 199 on Plan 1911 designated as PART 3 on Plan 64R-15959.

The easterly limit of Shermount Avenue as confirmed under the Boundaries Act by Plan BA-1401 (Instrument NY751505, Plan 10882) in the Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of North York) and Province of Ontario is laid out and dedicated for public highway purposes to form part of Glencairn Avenue.
