**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 327-2002**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, to establish bicycle lanes on Jones Avenue from Danforth Avenue to Queen Street East.**

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law was published in a daily newspaper on June 30, July 7, 14 and 21, 1998 and interested parties were given an opportunity to be heard at a the public meeting held on July 22, 1998;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
  - A. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Jones Avenue	Both, adjacent to curb lane used for parking	Danforth Avenue to Queen Street East
