## BY-LAW No. 344-2002

## To repeal and replace By-law No. 290-2002 and to provide for a permanent Clothing Optional Area at Hanlan's Point Beach.

WHEREAS by the adoption of Clause No. 1 of Report No. 7 of the Economic Development Committee on May 11 and 12, 1999, Council approved a one year pilot project for the implementation of a clothing optional beach at Hanlan's Point Beach; and

WHEREAS by the adoption, as amended, of Clause No. 2 of Report No. 2 of the Economic Development and Parks Committee on February 29, March 1 and 2, 2000, Council approved an extension of the pilot project for a clothing optional beach in the designated area along the westerly edge of Hanlan's Point Beach for two operating seasons in 2000 and 2001; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 290-2002 provided that by the adoption of Clause No. 4 of Report No. 2 of the Economic Development and Parks Committee on April 16, 17 and 18, 2002, Council approved the designated area as a permanent site for a clothing optional beach; and

WHEREAS the correct approval authority for the permanent designation is Clause No. 4 of Report No. 3 of the Economic Development and Parks Committee, adopted by Council on April 16, 17 and 18, 2002;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law No. 290-2002 is repealed.
- 2. The area shown outlined on the attached Schedule "A" is designated as a permanent clothing optional beach.


