CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 361-2002

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,
respecting Day Avenue, Idyllwood Crescent, Perth Avenue, Ridley Gardens and
Rusholme Park Crescent.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1)	(From Column 2)	(From Column 3)	(From Column 4)
Idyllwood Crescent	North	A point 81 metres west of Clendenan Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Perth Avenue	East	A point 14 metres south of Wallace Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Ridley Gardens	West	A point 72 metres north of Garden Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Rusholme Park Crescent	North	A point 36 metres west of Rusholme Road and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Day Avenue	East	A point 67 metres north of Hope Street and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
