CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 367-2002

To amend Scarborough Employment Districts Zoning By-law No. 24982, as amended, with respect to the Milliken Employment District.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. SCHEDULE "C", EXCEPTIONS LIST, is amended by adding the following Exception No. 447 to lands outlined on Schedule '1':

447. On those lands identified as Exception No. 447 on Schedule '1' the following shall apply:

Additional Permitted Uses

Vehicle rental and leasing

Ancillary Uses

- Open storage of vehicles in conjunction with a vehicle rental and leasing operation.
- Minor vehicle repair and washing in conjunction with a vehicle rental and leasing operation.

Parking

A maximum of 3 parking spaces shall be permitted in the front yard.

2. SCHEDULE "A", Milliken Employment District, is amended by adding Exception No. 447 to lands outlined on Schedule '1' so that the zoning for the lands shall read:

M – 414 – 913 – 991 – 1054 – 2007

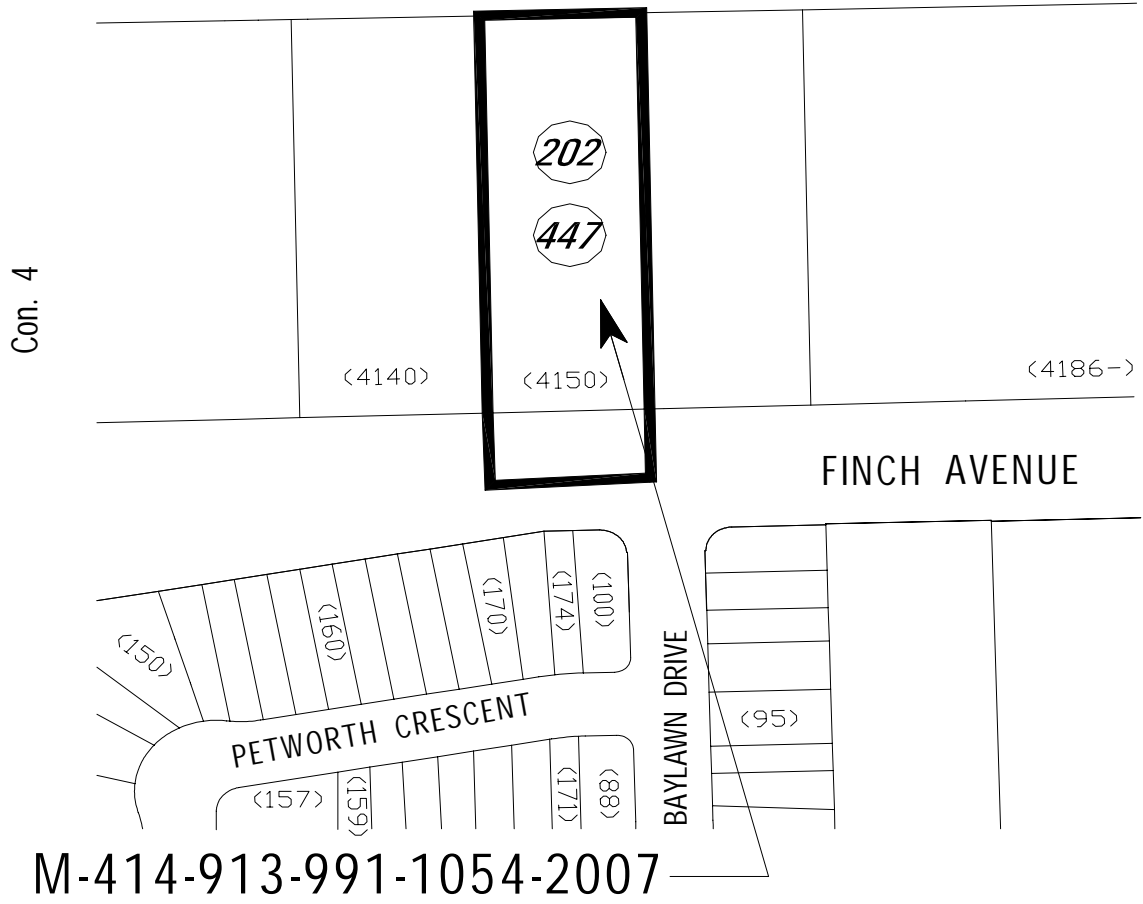
