**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 375-2002**

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking,  
respecting Bridgman Avenue, Edith Drive.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:
  - A. By inserting in Schedule XXXVIII (Designated On-Street Parking for Disabled Person Parking Permit Holders) in § 400-91, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| Bridgman<br>Avenue | North            | A point 11 metres west of Albany Avenue<br>and a point 5.5 metres further west                 | Anytime          |
| Edith Drive        | West             | A point 57.0 metres north of Orchard View<br>Boulevard and a point 5.5 metres further<br>north | Anytime          |
