BY-LAW No. 426-2002

To amend former City of North York By-law No. 7625 in respect of lands municipally known as 24 Drewry Avenue.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Schedules "B" and "C" of By-law No. 7625 of the former City of North York are amended in accordance with Schedule "1" of this By-law.
- **2.** Section 64.23 of By-law No. 7625 of the former City of North York is amended by adding the following subsections:

"64.23(101) C1(101)

PERMITTED USES

- (a) The following are the only permitted uses:
 - business and professional offices
 - personal service shops
 - retail stores
- **3.** Section 64.23(101) is amended by the addition of Schedule C1(101)".
