CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 441-2002

To layout and dedicate certain land for public lane purposes to form part of the public lane south of Danforth Avenue extending westerly from Kelvin Avenue, then southerly.

WHEREAS the City is the owner of certain land acquired in connection with the Committee of Adjustment Decisions B144/00T0 and B132/00T0 respecting 15 Trent Avenue;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land forming the lane south of Danforth Avenue extending westerly from Kelvin Avenue, then southerly, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) being composed of:

FIRSTLY: Land abutting 15 Trent Avenue

PIN 21013-0088 (LT)

Parts of Lots 66, 67, 68 and 69 on Plan 766 designated as PART 14 on Plan 64R-16898.

SECONDLY: Land abutting 40 Kelvin Avenue

Part of PIN 21013-0093 (LT)

Parts of Lots 80 and 81 on Plan 766 designated as PART 4 on Plan 64R-16919 is laid out and dedicated for public lane purposes.
