CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 446-2002

To authorize the entering into of an agreement for the provision of Municipal Capital Facilities respecting the Black Creek Neighbourhood Branch Library.

WHEREAS subsection 210.1(2) of the *Municipal Act* provides that the council of a municipality may enter into agreements for the provision of municipal capital facilities with any person; and

WHEREAS paragraph 11 of section 2 of Ontario Regulation 46/94, as amended, prescribes municipal facilities for public libraries as eligible municipal capital facilities; and

WHEREAS Council is desirous of entering into an agreement for the provision of municipal capital facilities with the property owner of the North York Sheridan Mall at 1700 Wilson Avenue in respect of the land to be leased by the Toronto Public Library Board for the relocation of its Black Creek Branch;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The City of Toronto is authorized to enter into an agreement under section 210.1(2) of the *Municipal Act* with the property owner of the North York Sheridan Mall for the provision of a municipal capital facility for the Black Creek Neighbourhood Branch Library with respect to the land to be leased by the Toronto Public Library Board at the North York Sheridan Mall at 1700 Wilson Avenue.
