BY-LAW No. 447-2002

To amend By-law No. 1108-2001, being a By-law “To appoint an Acting City Solicitor”.

WHEREAS at its meeting of December 4, 5 and 5, 2001, City Council enacted By-law No. 1108-2001, being a By-law “To appoint an Acting City Solicitor”; and

WHEREAS section 1 of By-law No. 1108-2001 repealed By-law No. 29-1998, which by-law, in addition to appointing the City Solicitor, delineated the duties and responsibilities of the City Solicitor;

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend By-law No. 1108-2001 so as to repeal only section 1 of By-law No. 29-1998;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 1108-2001 is amended by deleting section 1 and replacing it with “By-law No. 29-1998, as amended, is amended by deleting section 1”.
2. This by-law is deemed to have come into force on February 6, 2002.
