BY-LAW No. 505-2002

To amend former City of North York By-law No. 7625 in respect of lands municipally known as 2275 Bayview Avenue.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the *Planning Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Schedules "B" and "C" of By-law No. 7625, are amended in accordance with Schedule "1" of this By-law.
- 2. Section 64.21 of By-law No. 7625 is amended by adding the following subsection:

"64.21(7) G(7)

PERMITTED USES

(a) In addition to the uses permitted in the G zone, the following uses shall also be permitted: University Uses and Accessory Uses.

EXCEPTION REGULATIONS

(b) Gross Floor Area

The maximum gross floor area for all uses shall be 5,100 square metres".

2. By-law No. 427-2002 is hereby repealed.
