BY-LAW No. 513-2002

To amend further City of Toronto By-law No. 574-2000, a by-law "Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, businesses and occupations in the City of Toronto", regarding Watch for Bikes stickers in taxicabs.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Section 36(1) of Schedule 8 to By-law No. 574-2000, a by-law respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, businesses and occupations in the City of Toronto, as amended, is amended by adding the following subsection (h):
 - (h) three "Watch for Bikes" stickers, in a form approved by the Commissioner or his or her delegate, one affixed to the driver's side mirror, one affixed to the right rear side window and one affixed to the left rear side window, affixed in manner that will not obstruct the driver's view.
