**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 528-2002**

**To exempt land municipally known as 3270 Kingston Road and 5 Bellamy Road South  
from Part Lot Control.**

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990,  
c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, does not apply to the lands described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
2. This By-law expires one year after its enactment by Council.
