BY-LAW No. 532-2002

To further amend Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, re: various streets in connection with World Youth Day events.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the said Schedule:

Sheppard Avenue West (M.T. 28)	Both	Jane Street and Keele Street	Anytime

2. This by-law shall be in force commencing July 26, 2002 and shall automatically expire on July 28, 2002 at 11:59 p.m. and thereafter be of no force and effect.
3. To the extent that there is a conflict between this by-law and any other provision(s) of the former Metropolitan Toronto Uniform Traffic By-law No. 32-92, as amended, or any Code provision(s) in the former City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, this new by-law shall prevail.
