**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 533-2002**

**To further amend Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic  
on former Metropolitan Roads, re: various streets in connection with  
World Youth Day events.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XI (No Standing) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the said Schedule:

| Bloor Street West<br>(M.T. 10) | Both             | Dufferin Street and Ossington<br>Avenue        | Anytime          |
| Bloor Street West<br>(M.T. 10) | Both             | Spadina Avenue and Yonge<br>Street             | Anytime          |
| Dundas Street West<br>M.T. 8)  | Both             | Beverly Street and Bay Street                  | Anytime          |
| University Avenue<br>(M.T. 25) | Both             | Wellington Street West and<br>King Street West | Anytime          |

2. This by-law shall come into force commencing on July 23, 2002 at 7:00 a.m. and shall automatically expire on July 27, 2002 at 7:01 a.m. and thereafter be of no force and effect.
3. To the extent that there is a conflict between this by-law and any of Sections 21, 22, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 31, 32, 34 and 35 of the former Metropolitan Toronto Uniform Traffic By-law No. 32-92, as amended, this by-law shall prevail.
