## BY-LAW No. 533-2002

## To further amend Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads, re: various streets in connection with World Youth Day events.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XI (No Standing) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the said Schedule:

Bloor Street West (M.T. 10)	Both	Dufferin Street and Ossington Avenue	Anytime
Bloor Street West (M.T. 10)	Both	Spadina Avenue and Yonge Street	Anytime

University Avenue (M.T. 25)	Both	Wellington Street West and King Street West	Anytime

- 2. This by-law shall come into force commencing on July 23, 2002 at 7:00 a.m. and shall automatically expire on July 27, 2002 at 7:01 a.m. and thereafter be of no force and effect.
- 3. To the extent that there is a conflict between this by-law and any of Sections 21, 22, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 31, 32, 34 and 35 of the former Metropolitan Toronto Uniform Traffic By-law No. 32-92, as amended, this by-law shall prevail.
