BY-LAW No. 571-2002

To amend former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways, to designate a bicycle lane on Montrose Avenue between Harbord Street and Bloor Street West.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the designation of a bicycle lane on Montrose Avenue was published in a daily newspaper on May 14, 20, 27 and June 3, 2002 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on June 4, 2002 and it is appropriate to permit the designation;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Chapter 194, Footpaths, Bicycle Lanes and Pedestrian Ways of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended as follows:
 - A. By adding in alphabetical order to the list of bicycle lanes in § 194-6A, the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Montrose Avenue	East, adjacent to curb	Harbord Street and Bloor Street West
