BY-LAW No. 598-2002

**To amend By-law No. 2958-94 of the former City of York, being a By-law
“To regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS - SCHEDULE XVIII

1. That Schedule XVIII of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by deleting in Columns 1 and 2 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Between</u>
Buttonwood Avenue	The west limit of Charlton Settlement Avenue and the east limit of Laxis Avenue

STOP SIGNS – SCHEDULE XIX

2. That Schedule XIX of former City of York By-law No. 2958-94, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of said Schedule the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>INTERSECTION</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>STOP STREETS</u>
Buttonwood Avenue and Charlton Settlement Avenue/Verona Avenue	Buttonwood Avenue for east and westbound traffic
Birch Tree Crescent and Buttonwood Avenue	Birch Tree Crescent for southbound traffic
Charlton Settlement Avenue and Buttonwood Avenue	Charlton Settlement Avenue for southbound traffic
Forest Point Drive and Buttonwood Avenue	Forest Point Drive for southbound traffic
