CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 617-2002

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 447, Fences, to exempt a portion of the fence on the property municipally known as 1610 Woodbine Heights Boulevard from the minimum distance requirements for pool fences.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 447-5 of Chapter 447, Fences, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by adding the following after the last section:

The portion of the swimming pool enclosure surrounding the swimming pool located on the property known municipally in 2002 as 1610 Woodbine Heights Boulevard, may be retained despite the existence of a neighbouring decorative lattice fence that constitutes an external climbable condition measuring 1.5 metres in height and abutting the swimming pool enclosure, the lattice fence creating a violation of the requirement that external conditions be no closer than one metre to a swimming pool enclosure as set out in § 447-3E(1)(b), (c) and (d).
