BY-LAW No. 623-2002

To define the South Rosedale area as an area of the City of Toronto to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district.

1. The area within the heavy lines shown on the map attached as Schedule "A" is defined as an area to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, chapter O.18, as amended.
