**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 672-2002**

**To stop up and close a portion of Willowlea Drive, east of Scarboro Avenue.**

WHEREAS it is recommended that a portion of the public highway Willowlea Drive, east of Scarboro Avenue, be stopped up and closed as a public highway; and

WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law to stop up and close the said portion of Willowlea Drive was published in the Toronto Sun newspaper on August 23, 30, September 6 and 13, 2002 and no one who claimed that the person's land would be prejudicially affected by the said by-law applied to be heard;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of Willowlea Drive, east of Scarboro Avenue, described as follows:

Part of PIN 06194-0255 (LT)

Being part of Block A dedicated by Corporation of Scarborough Township By-law No. 9068 (SC253450) and part of Willowlea Drive on Plan 2098, designated as PARTS 1 and 2 on Plan 64R-16178, Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66), in the City of Toronto (formerly City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario is hereby stopped up and closed as a public highway.
