BY-LAW No. 689-2002

To authorize the alteration of Liberty Street from Atlantic Avenue to Hanna Avenue by narrowing the pavement on the south side and constructing a sidewalk.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the alteration of Liberty Street from Atlantic Avenue to Hanna Avenue by narrowing the pavement on the south side and constructing a sidewalk was published in a daily newspaper on August 26, September 2, September 9 and September 16, 2002 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 17, 2002 and it is appropriate to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The narrowing of the pavement from a width of 11.0 metres to a width of 9.5 metres on the south side of Liberty Street, from Atlantic Avenue to Hanna Avenue, for the purpose of constructing a sidewalk, generally as shown on Drawing No. M-3847-4, dated April, 2002.
