BY-LAW No. 690-2002

To rename Lower Portland Street between Front Street West and Queens Quay West as “Dan Leckie Way”.

WHEREAS notice of a public hearing on September 17, 2002 with respect to the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was advertised in a daily newspaper on August 26, September 2, September 9 and September 16, 2002, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard, and it is appropriate to rename Lower Portland Street between Front Street West and Queens Quay West as “Dan Leckie Way”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Lower Portland Street between Front Street West and Queens Quay West described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

The Public Highway Lower Portland Street dedicated by City of Toronto By-laws Nos. 1997-0323 (CA486960) and 954-1998 (CA583345) being parts of Blocks G and H on Plan D-1397 designated as PART 17 on Plan 63R-4999 and PARTS 3 and 4 on Plan 64R-15652 in the Registry Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario is renamed Dan Leckie Way.
