BY-LAW No. 692-2002

To authorize the alteration of Milvan Drive at Toryork Drive by the realignment of the intersection to promote free flow of traffic.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the alteration of Milvan Drive at Toryork Drive by realignment of the intersection to promote free flow of traffic was published in a daily newspaper on August 26, September 2, September 9 and September 16, 2002 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 18, 2002 and it is appropriate to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:

The intersection of Milvan Drive at Toryork Drive be realigned as such to promote free flow of northbound traffic on Toryork Drive onto westbound Milvan Drive and eastbound traffic on Milvan Drive onto southbound Toryork Drive, as per Drawing No. NY-1404A dated April 23, 2002.
