BY-LAW No. 693-2002

To rename Breeders Circle as “Green Meadows Circle”.

WHEREAS notice of a public hearing on September 18, 2002 with respect to the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was advertised in a daily newspaper on August 26, September 2, September 9 and September 16, 2002, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard, and it is appropriate to rename Breeders Circle as “Green Meadows Circle”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The public highway Breeders Circle described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 10055-0371 (LT)

Breeders Circle on Plan 66M-2382 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of North York) and Province of Ontario is renamed Green Meadows Circle.
