BY-LAW No. 694-2002

To rename a portion of “Brookwell Drive” extending easterly from Sentinel Road as “Streamdale Court”.

WHEREAS notice of a public hearing on September 18, 2002 with respect to the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was advertised in a daily newspaper on August 26, September 2, September 9 and September 16, 2002, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard, and it is appropriate to rename a portion of Brookwell Drive extending easterly from Sentinel Road as “Streamdale Court”, the two private lanes at YCC No. 108 extending easterly from Sentinel Road as “Enclave Mews” and “Inlet Mews”, and to amend the municipal addresses for the units in YCC No. 108 accordingly;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of Brookwell Drive described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

PIN 10250-0225 (LT)

Brookwell Drive on Plan 6539 east of Sentinel Road in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of North York) and Province of Ontario is renamed Streamdale Court.
