BY-LAW No. 695-2002

To authorize the alteration of Leona Drive, north of Lyndale Drive, by the construction of a new cul-de-sac and the retention of an existing temporary barrier approximately 20 metres south of Sheppard Avenue East until the earlier of the new cul-de-sac construction or the end of the year 2003.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the alteration of Leona Drive, north of Lyndale Drive, by the construction of a new cul-de-sac and the retention of an existing temporary barricade, was published in a daily newspaper on August 26, September 2, September 9 and September 16, 2002 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on September 18, 2002 and it is appropriate to permit the alteration;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following alteration is authorized:
 - A. Leona Drive, north of Lyndale Drive, by the construction of a new cul-de-sac.
 - B. Leona Drive, approximately 20 metres south of Sheppard Avenue East, by the retention of the existing temporary barricade until the earlier of the new cul-de-sac construction or the end the year 2003.
