BY-LAW No. 696-2002

To rename a portion of Crouse Road between Underwriters Road and Crockford Boulevard as “Underwriters Road”.

WHEREAS notice of a public hearing on September 17, 2002 with respect to the proposed enactment of the draft by-law was advertised in a daily newspaper on August 26, September 2, September 9 and September 16, 2002, and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard, and it is appropriate to rename a portion of Crouse Road between Underwriters Road and Crockford Boulevard as “Underwriters Road”;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The portion of Crouse Road west of Underwriters Road described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

Part of PIN 06336-0049 (LT)

Crouse Road and the One Foot Reserve abutting the easterly limit of Crouse Road on Plan 4297 and Crouse Road on Plan 4329.

SAVING and EXCEPTING thereout and therefrom the easterly 213.36 metres of the said Crouse Road on Plan 4329 in the Land Titles Division of the Toronto Registry Office (No. 66) in the City of Toronto (formerly in the City of Scarborough) and Province of Ontario is renamed Underwriters Road.
