**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 724-2002**

**To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIX (Compulsory Stops) of By-law No. 92-93, entitled “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Gardens Crescent and Selwyn Avenue

Gardens Crescent (eastbound)

Selwyn Avenue and Gardens Crescent

Selwyn Avenue (northbound and southbound)
