CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 732-2002

To amend further By-law No. 271, a By-law “To prohibit parking on certain sides of certain highways”, being a By-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule “A” to By-law No. 117-79, entitled “To establish school bus loading zones on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a By-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by deleting the following words and figures where they appear opposite each other in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of the said Schedule:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)
Plains Road	North	A point 38 metres east of Woodmount Avenue and a point 77.5 metres east of Woodmount Avenue

2. Schedule “A” to By-law No. 117-79, entitled “To establish school bus loading zones on roads in the Borough of East York”, as amended, being a By-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures opposite each other in Columns 1, 2 and 3 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)
Plains Road	North	A point 81.8 metres east of Woodmount Avenue and a point 180.3 metres east of Woodmount Avenue

3. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
